SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISH OF FORNHAM ALL SAINTS) (B1106 WESTLEY ROAD ALSO KNOWN AS TUT HILL) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY WITH EXEMPTIONS) ORDER 2023

On 3rd April 2023 Suffolk County Council made the above order for Westley Road under Section 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) and part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which would be to prohibit entry except for pedal cycles to:

- B1106 Westley Road (also known as Tut Hill) northbound from the junction with Marham Parkway
- B1106 Westley Road (also known as Tut Hill) southbound from a point 710 metres south west of the junction with A1101 Bury Road

Exemptions to the restrictions allow access for the emergency services and the Council's agents and/or employees for maintenance purposes.

A copy of the order which comes into effect on 6th April 2023 and a map showing the length of road affected, may be seen with advance notice at the address below 9:00 am - 5:00 pm Monday - Friday; also at Bury St Edmunds Library, Sergeants Walk, St Andrews Street North, Bury St Edmunds, IP33 1TZ: 8:30 am – 5:30pm Monday, Wednesday and Thursday; 8:30 am to 7:30pm Tuesday and Friday; 8:30am – 5:00pm Saturday; and 10:00 am to 4:00 pm Sunday.

If anyone wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any of the requirements of the Act or any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, they may within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made apply to the High Court for this purpose.
